Letters from School

This article is a bit different from the usual monthly stories we share from our Global Helps Network ministries. Below are some letters from 6th-grade students at our K-10th school and how Global Helps Network and our partners in India have helped them and brought change to their lives. Names and location information have been changed for security purposes. I hope you enjoy getting to know a few of our students:

"I was born in a poor Hindu family and grew up to the age of five in the tradition of our village. I used to visit local temples and worshipping places for prayers and pujas.



When I was five years old, my parents sent me to a local school where teachers were not regular, or they didn't teach us. I was afraid that I may lose my future without education. One day, the management of Global Helps Network School visited my house and promised a free and quality education and for that my mother agreed to send me to the school. At the school, teachers teach us very interesting things and am very happy. I am hopeful now that my life will be settled in future since I got a chance to study and get good grades. May God bless our management with enough resources to care for poor children like me."

"Here I get good food, care and high-quality education that will give me a good career. My life would have been different if I had not been called by them to the school."

"Glory to God. I am studying in the sixth grade at English school. I lost my parents in my early childhood and was brought up by my uncle. Since he was employed and had to look after his family, it became a burden for him to send me to school. I was about to lose my studies when Global Helps Network management visited our house and asked my uncle to send me to school for a very low annual payment. Here I get good food, care and high-quality education that will



give me a good career. My life would have been different if I had not been called by them to the school. I thank the management for making me Jesus own child by teaching the words of Jesus and the Bible."

Global Helps Network currently supports two schools in India. One is a Kindergarten school on the edge of the city now preparing to expand to K-5th, and the other is a K-10th school with over 400 students.



Both are poised to change the lives of the disenfranchised in some of the poorest regions in India. Education opens doors to children like our two sixth-graders. Our



schools always charge the lowest possible annual tuition and sometime enroll children for free. Global Helps never lets money become a barrier to the poor. Our teachers model Christian values and attempt to show the love of Jesus through how they live and be a light for change in the community daily.
